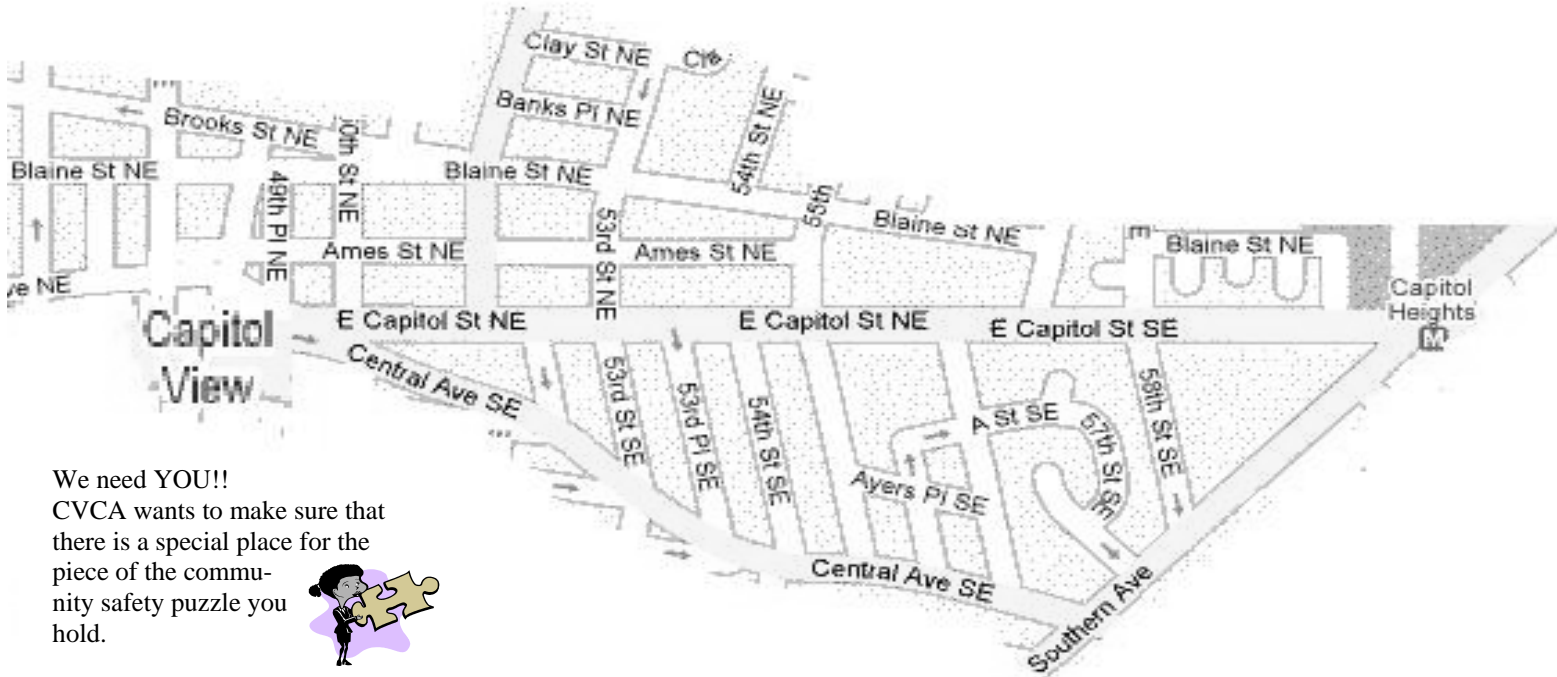

CVCA Makes Impressive Strides for Community Safety in 2008—Mayor Fenty Focuses City Resources in Capitol View for CVCA

Since CVCA launched its central theme for the 2008-2009 year of Community Safety we have made impressive strides towards implementing measures to assure citizen safety in our communities. Our efforts have garnered **three visits from the Mayor in 3 months** with a commitment from him to address our needs and concerns. As a result:

- We have had 30 new speed humps installed throughout our neighborhoods!
- Alley lighting has been either installed or upgraded throughout Capitol View
- Street patrols from MPD have been increased for our protection!
- Several drug houses have been raided and arrests made around Clay Terrace
- Traffic Cameras are scheduled to be installed on East Capitol by January 2009
- Additional crime cameras are being negotiated on to aid in neighborhood protection
